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ROUTES OF ENTRY: Inhalation Skin Ingestion

HEALTH HAZARD (Acute and Chronic): Irritant to eyes and skin. May cause sensitization by skin contact if a person is allergic to any of the ingredients.

INHALATION: May cause irritation.

INGESTION: May cause irritation of the digestive tract.

EYES: Causes eye irritation.

SKIN: May cause skin irritation.

INHALATION: Supply fresh air and contact a physician if irritation persists.

EYE CONTACT: Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, lifting lower and upper eyelids occasionally. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.

SKIN CONTACT: Flush skin with plenty of soap and water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.

INGESTION: Do not induce vomiting – give large volumes of water. Seek medical attention.

SECTION 7 - PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

IN CASE OF RELEASE OR SPILL: Cover with absorbent material. Collect spilled material. Clean up residue.

WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD: In accordance with local, state and federal regulations.

STORAGE, HANDLING, AND SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS: Store in cool and dark place. Keep receptacle tightly sealed. Store away from heat.
